## Judging Criteria

following criteria

Interpretation of the THEME

Technical Skill

Originality

Level of Difficulty

They cannot duplicate a picture from a magazine, cal-  
endar, internet or other commercially published work

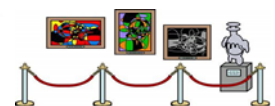


### Category 3
